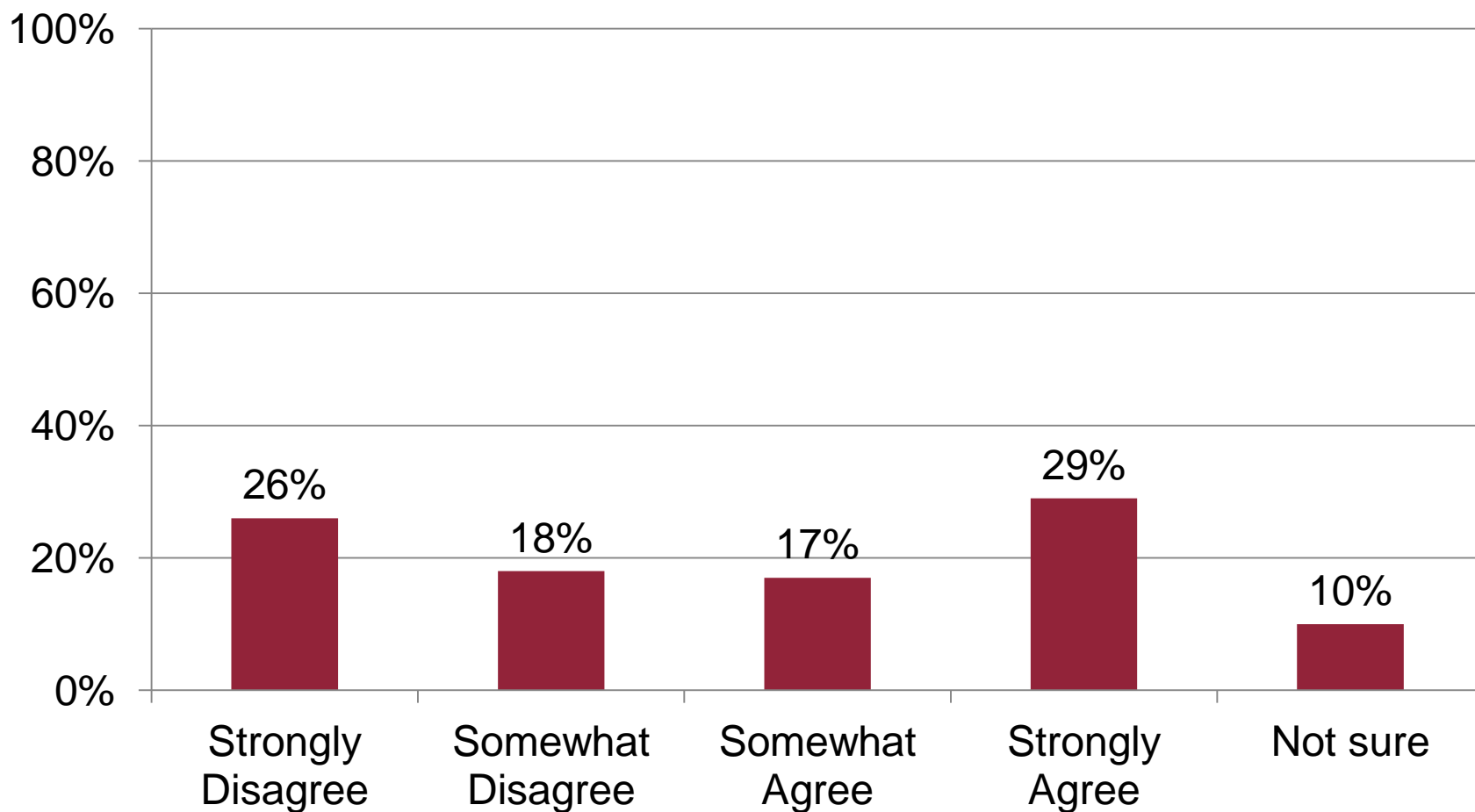
Phone Survey of 1,000 Americans

Methodology

- ❑ The phone survey of Americans was conducted September 19-28, 2014
- ❑ The calling utilized Random Digit Dialing. 60% of completes were among landlines and 40% among cell phones
- ❑ Maximum quotas and slight weights were used for gender, region, age, ethnicity, and education to more accurately reflect the population
- ❑ The completed sample is 1,000 surveys
- ❑ The sample provides 95% confidence that the sampling error does not exceed $\pm 3.4\%$
- ❑ Margins of error are higher in sub-groups

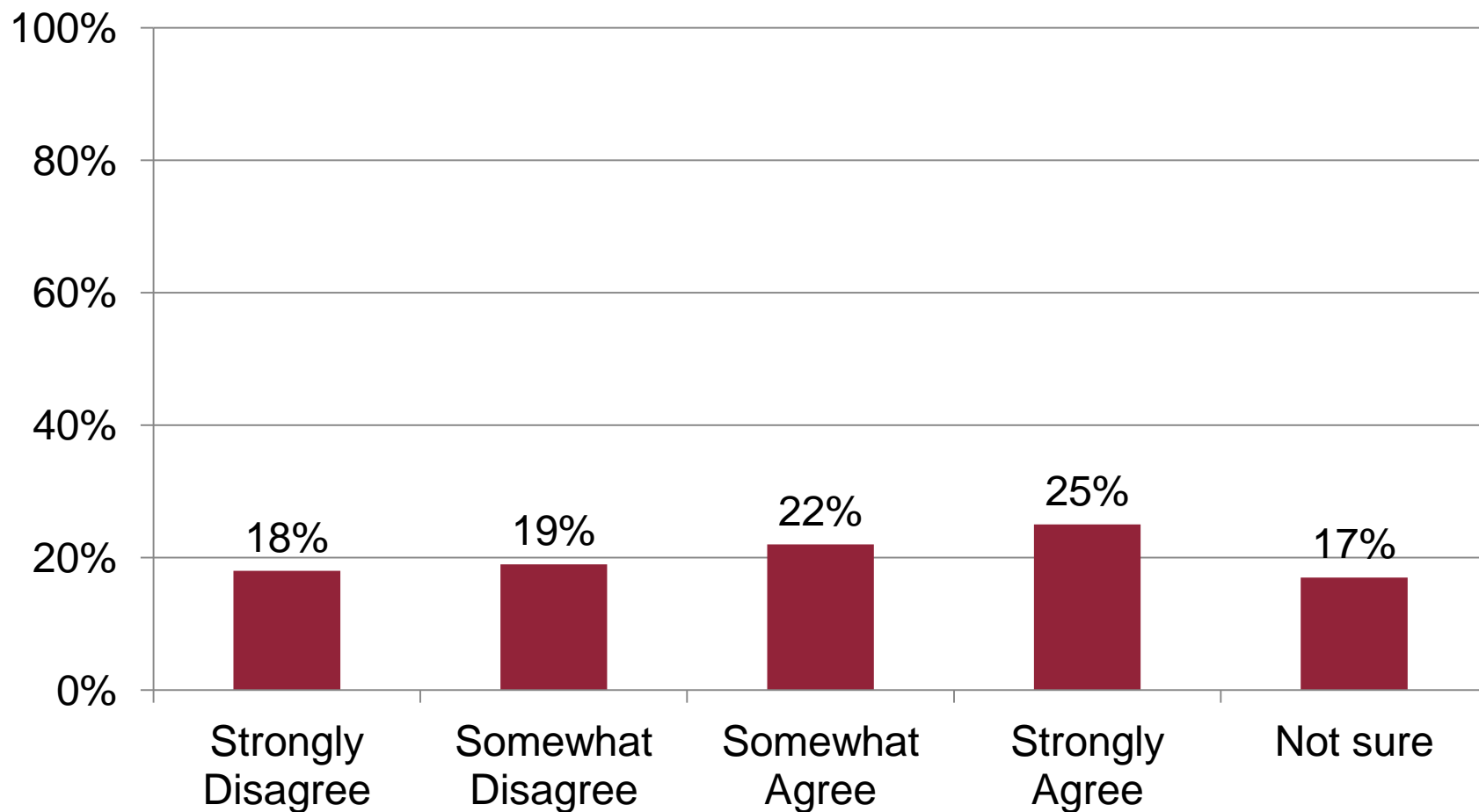
Survey Responses

46% of Americans agree the Jews are God's chosen people



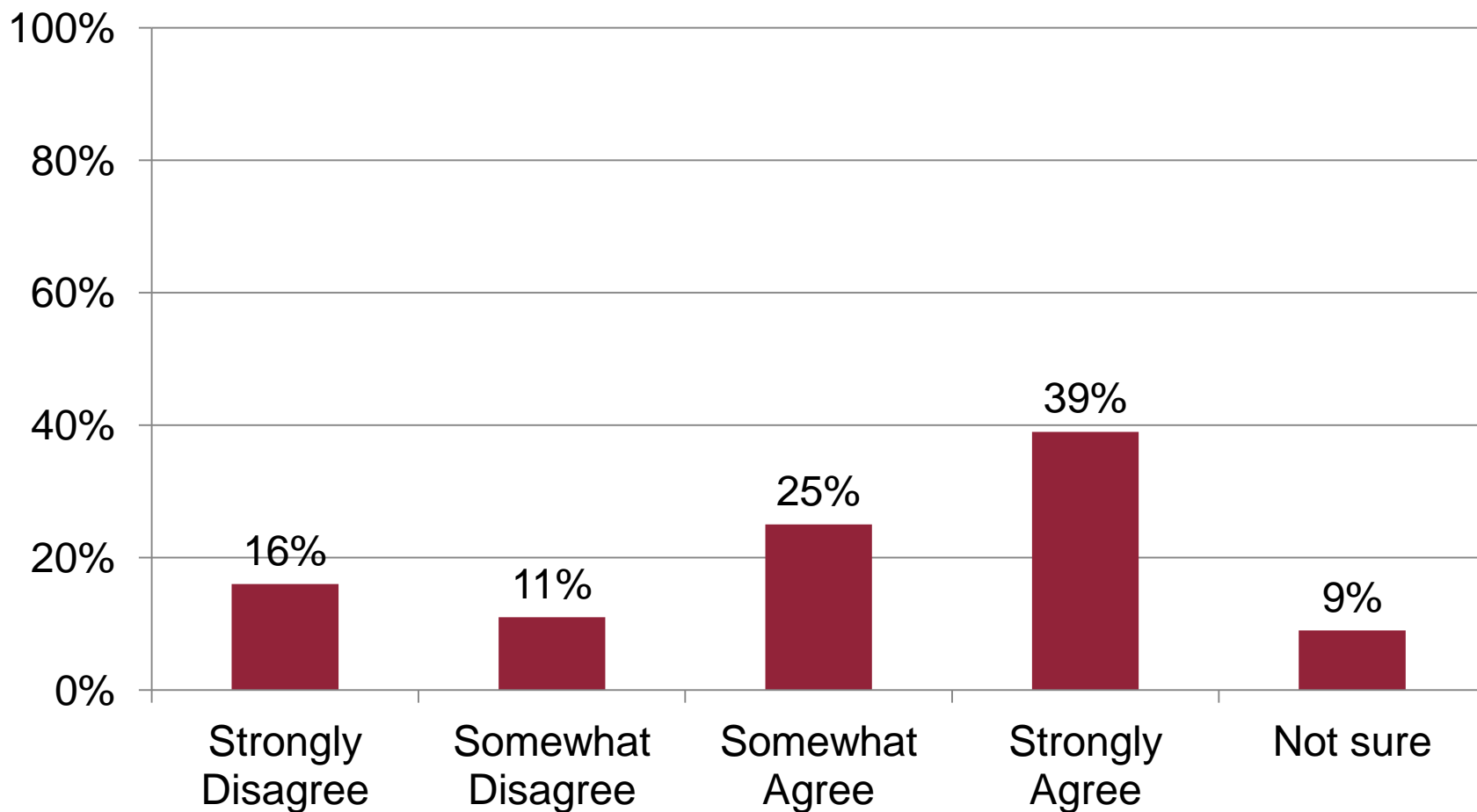
Q: "The Jews are God's chosen people"

46% of Americans agree the formation of modern Israel is a fulfillment of biblical prophecy



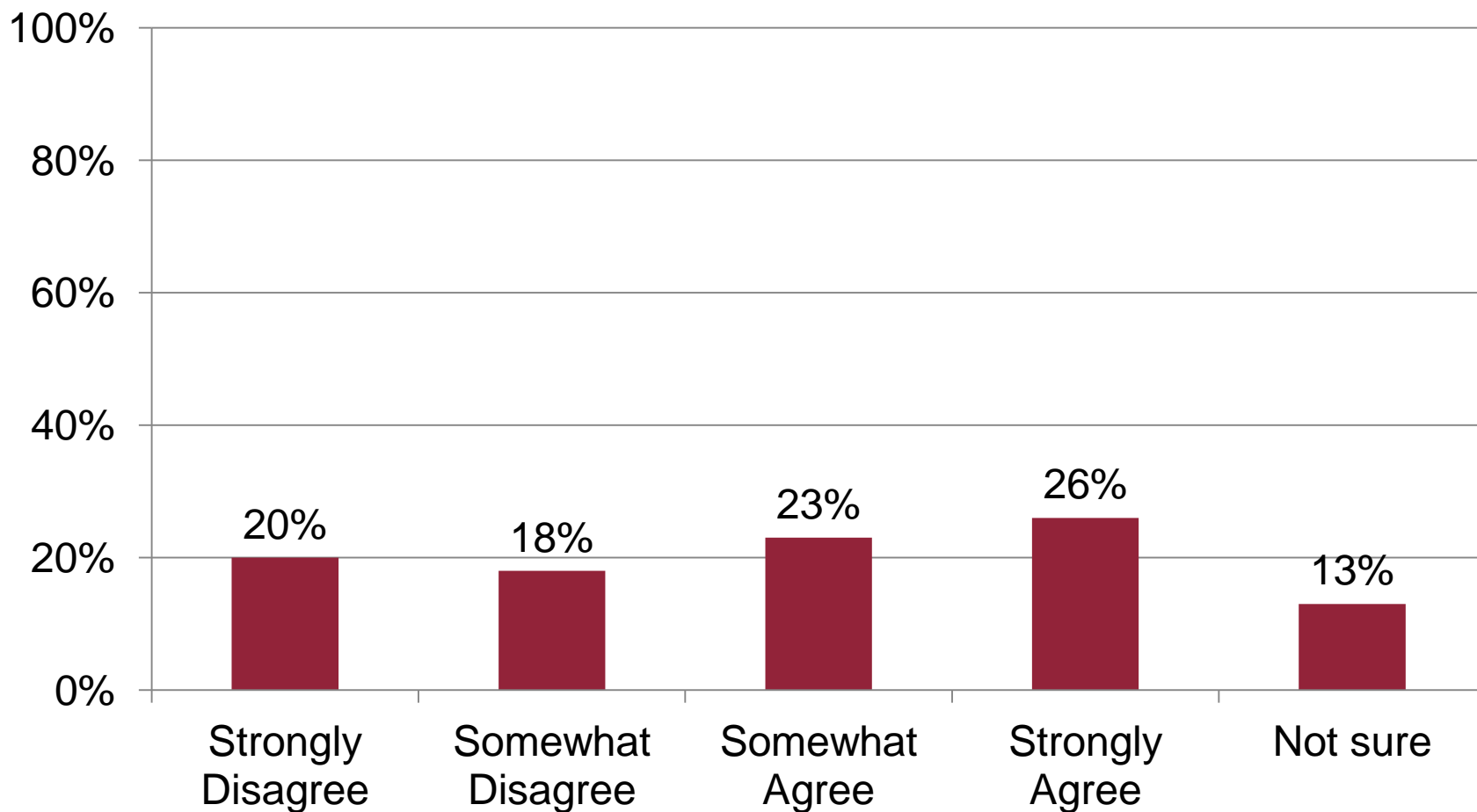
Q: "The formation of modern Israel is a fulfillment of biblical prophecy"

64% of Americans agree God had a special relationship with ancient Israel



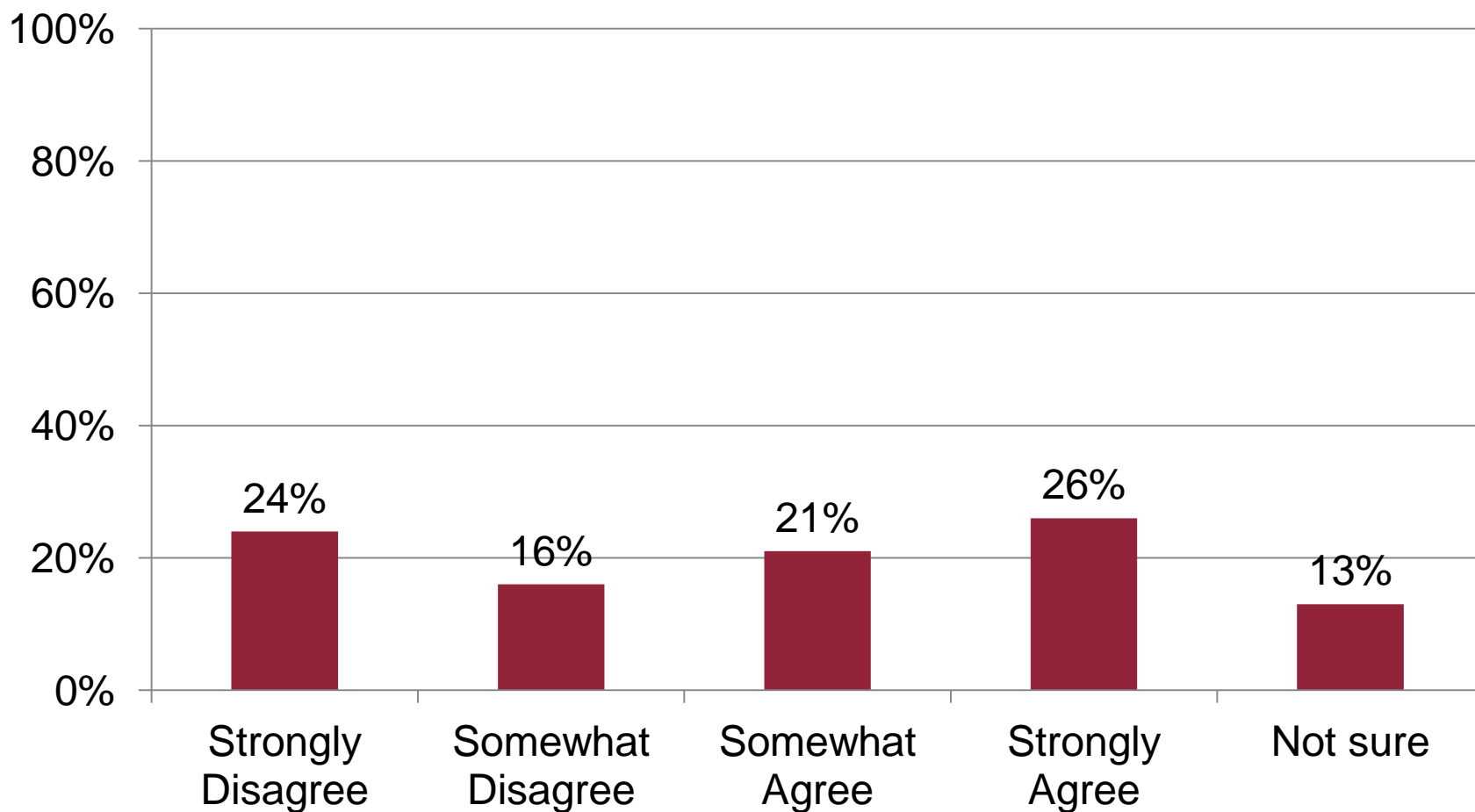
Q: "God had a special relationship with ancient Israel"

Significant Statistical Differences

Comparisons were made to determine if there are any significant statistical differences among region of the country, age, gender, and education level.

Significant Statistical Differences

Comparisons were made to determine if there are any significant statistical differences among ethnicity, religious preference, denomination, and Born again/ Evangelical/ Fundamentalist.

The Jews are God's chosen people

- Westerners (39%) are less likely to agree than Midwesterners (49%) and Southerners (51%)
- Those age 25-34 (36%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (52%), 55-64 (48%), and 65+ (52%)
- Those with a HS degree or less (51%) are more likely to agree than those with some college (43%), who are more likely than those with a graduate degree (31%)
- Christians (52%) are more likely to agree than Other Religions (41%), who are more likely than Nonreligious (20%)
- Protestants (56%) are more likely to agree than Catholics (43%)
- Evangelicals are more likely to agree (66% v 37%)

The formation of modern Israel is a fulfillment of biblical prophecy

- Men are less likely to agree (43% v 50%)
- Southerners (57%) are most likely to agree, while Westerners (34%) are least likely
- Those age 18-24 (35%) and 25-34 (37%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (53%), 55-64 (52%), and 65+ (57%)
- Those age 35-44 (45%) are less likely to agree than those age 65+ (57%)
- Those with a HS degree or less (51%) are more likely to agree than those with some college (43%) or a graduate degree (34%)
- Christians (53%) are more likely to agree than Other Religions (39%), who are more likely than Nonreligious (23%)
- Catholics (44%) are less likely to agree than Protestants (56%)
- Evangelicals are more likely to agree (69% v 36%)

God had a special relationship with ancient Israel

- Northeasterners (61%) and Westerners (58%) are less likely to agree than Southerners (70%)
- Those age 25-34 (57%) and 35-44 (60%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (73%)
- Those with a graduate degree are least likely to agree (47%)
- Those with a HS degree or less (69%) are more likely to agree than those with a Bachelor's (60%)
- Christians (71%) are more likely to agree than Other Religions (59%), who are more likely than Nonreligious (36%)
- Protestants are more likely to agree than Catholics (74% v 61%)
- Evangelicals are more likely to agree (86% v 54%)

God has a special relationship with modern Israel

- Southerners (55%) are more likely to agree than Midwesterners (45%) and Westerners (41%)
- Those age 35-44 (40%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (60%), 55-64 (52%) and 65+ (52%)
- Those age 45-54 (60%) are more likely to agree than those age 18-24 (46%) and 25-34 (42%)
- Those with a graduate degree are least likely to agree (30%)
- Those with a HS degree or less (53%) are more likely to agree than those with a Bachelor's (44%)
- Nonreligious (26%) are less likely to agree than Christians (53%) and Other Religions (43%)
- Protestants (56%) are more likely to agree than Catholics (47%)
- Evangelicals are more likely to agree (70% v 38%)

I believe the events in Israel are all part of the prophecies in the Book of Revelation

- Women are more likely to agree (52% v 42%)
- Southerners (57%) are most likely to agree
- Northeasterners (30%) and Westerners (30%) are more likely to strongly disagree than Southerners (17%)
- Those age 18-24 (36%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (55%), 55-64 (51%), and 65+ (50%)
- Those age 35-44 (43%) are less likely to agree than those age 45-54 (55%)
- Those with a HS degree or less are most likely to agree (55%) while those with a graduate degree are least likely to agree (24%)
- Christians (53%) are more likely to strongly agree than Other Religions (41%), who are more likely than Nonreligious (25%)
- Protestants (58%) are more likely to agree than Catholics (39%)
- Evangelicals are more likely to agree (73% v 35%)
