
A SURVEY OF 1,001 AMERICAN PROTESANT CHURCH SWITCHERS

Methodology

- The online survey of 1,001 American Protestant churchgoers was conducted July 26-August 4, 2023, using a national pre-recruited panel
- Respondents were screened to include those who identified as Protestant/non-denominational who attend church worship services at least twice a month and have attended more than one church as an adult
- Note: During the screening, it was determined that 47% of Protestants who attend church worship services at least twice a month have only attended one church as an adult
- Quotas were used to balance gender, age, region, ethnicity, education, and religion to more accurately reflect the population
- The completed sample is 1,001 surveys
- The sample provides 95% confidence that the sampling error from the panel does not exceed <u>+</u>3.1% This margin of error accounts for the effect of weighting
- Margins of error are higher in sub-groups


Among Protestant churchgoers who have regularly attended more than one church as an adult, 85% have regularly attended less than six

60% decided to attend their current church due to a residential move



Factors influencing adults to switch churches (other than a residential move)



































Comparison of previous and current churches


52% say their need/desire to join their current church most impacted their decision to switch churches


Worship style of previous and current churches


In 2006, all three shifts were significant. Today only the shift away from Traditional and to a Mix are significant




































Comparison of current and previous church (1 of 3)




Comparison of current and previous church (2 of 3)




Movers v. Non-Movers current church meets needs More/Much More than previous church








"Which of the following best describe the preaching at your previous/current churches?"


73% consider themselves a Christian with strong faith




"In what ways were you/are you involved in your previous and current churches?"




Current Church: Switchers are less likely to be attending worship in person and financially supporting their current church than in 2006



Comparison of average worship attendance at their current and previous church


Among Protestant Churchgoers who Switched Churches

Percent of Church Switchers who changed to a church in a different size category


Among Protestant Churchgoers who Switched Churches
