Percent Yes	69%	40%	32%	49%

- All regions are statistically significantly different from all others.
- Northeast (69%) are the most likely to be trained in reporting sexual abuse.
- South (32%) are the least likely to be trained in reporting sexual abuse.

Trained in Caring for Sexual Abuse Survivors

Percent Yes	27%	18%	14%	24%

- Northeast (27%) and West (24%) are the most likely to be trained in caring for sexual abuse survivors.
- South (14%) are the least likely to be trained in caring for sexual abuse survivors.

- 250 or more (94%) are the most likely to perform background checks.
- Less than 50 (35%) are the least likely to perform background checks.

Trained in Reporting Sexual Abuse

Percent Yes	24%	35%	48%	70%

- All attendance levels are statistically significantly different from all others.
- 250 or more (70%) are the most likely to be trained in reporting sexual abuse.
- Less than 50 (24%) are the least likely to be trained in reporting sexual abuse.

Trained in Caring for Sexual Abuse Survivors

	Less than 50	50 to 99	100 to 249	250 or more
Percent Yes	12%	14%	19%	28%

- All attendance levels are statistically significantly different from all others.
- 250 or more (28%) are the most likely to be trained in caring for sexual abuse survivors.
- Less than 50 (12%) are the least likely to be trained in caring for sexual abuse survivors.

- Post-2000 (72%) are the most likely to perform background checks.
- Pre-1900 (48%) and 1900-1949 (50%) are the least likely to perform background checks.

- Post-2000 (53%) are the most likely to be trained in reporting sexual abuse.
